EVACUATION PROCEDURE PALAIS DES FESTIVALS – CANNES

You must evacuate the Palais des Festivals de Cannes when you hear the following:

- In public areas, a message that says : "*Following a technical incident, you are requested to proceed calmly to the Palais des Festivals exits".* This message is broadcast in several languages interrupted by a sound signal broadcast.
- In zones that are exclusively work areas, the sound signal only is broadcast, for a period of five minutes.

When you hear these signals, you must leave the building via the nearest emergency exit to your workstation? and proceed to the following muster stations:

> The Esplanade des Alliés opposite the Majestic Beach for people leaving via the East and North-East sides of the building.

> The Parvis Croisette in front of Casino Barrière entrance for people leaving via the West side of the building.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WHATSOEVER SHOULD YOU REMAIN IN THE VICINITY OF THE BUILDING AND UNDER NO PRETEXT MAY YOU RETURN INSIDE THE BUILDING unless previously authorized to do so by the building's safety officers.

To proceed to the emergency exits, follow the signs (a green panel with white lettering) and the emergency lighting showing you which way to go.

Emergency exits are located:

LEVEL 01

Around the edge of the whole of this level Two in the center of each of Zones 1, 2 and 3

LEVEL 0

Main entrance Stage Door Professionals Lobby

FROM LEVEL 1 TO LEVEL 6

The two central staircases The main staircase of the interior street Outside staircases on the port and sea side

In the Grand Auditorium foyers In the Debussy Theatre foyers The five towers around the edges of the Salon des Ambassadeurs The two staircases to the right and left of Auditoriums B, C, D, E and I, J

ESPACE RIVIERA

All round the edges of this level

ESPACE LERINS / SEA VIEW

All round the edges of this level

STRUCTURE AZUR 1 & AZUR 2

All round the edges of this structure

STRUCTURE SUNSET

The two staircases in front of the sea and the parvis (square)

STRUCTURE FREMANTLE

The tree external staircases

On all levels, close to each telephone handset you will find white, wall-mounted security telephones as well as safety and evacuation maps.

On arrival, take a few minutes to check out the nearest exists and the emergency resources such as fire extinguishers, etc. available in your working environment.
