

SITE RULES

All Exhibitors or Contractors working on site during the Construction phase (Build-up) and Dismantling phase (Breakdown) must adhere to the site rules below.

0	You are subject to French Labour Code You should not enter site if: You feel unwell
	No Unauthorised Access. Children under the age of 16 will not be permitted.
®	No smoking in exhibition halls or marked outside areas. This includes ecigarettes/vapes.
	Drinking of alcohol onsite during the build up and breakdown phase is forbidden. The taking of illegal drugs is strictly forbidden at all times.
(5)	Site speed limit of 5mph must be adhered to at all times.
	PPE including high visibility clothing and safety footwear must be worn by all personnel onsite during the build up and breakdown. Open toed shoes will not be permitted.
	Machine and tool guards must always be used. Non-guarded machinery will not be permitted to be used and non-guarded tools will be confiscated.
	Emergency Gangways and fire exits must be kept clear at all times.
	Dust – no cutting permitted onsite unless extracted at source by mechanical means.
	Trailing cables must be minimised wherever possible. Where they are required they must be clearly identified and used for the minimum time possible.
0	All working at height must be planned to minimise risks involved so far as is reasonably practicable.
0	All Accidents, Incidents and near misses must be reported immediately to the Organisers office located on Level 1 at the bottom of the stairs to the main entrance. Telephone number T: To be provided
